DOG PARK RULES

- Dog Park is for Newburgh Hts. **Residents Only.**
- Handlers may not bring more than 3 dogs.
- Registration and proof of vaccinations must be provided annually. Annual registration period commences May 1st of each year.
- All dogs must properly licensed, vaccinated and wear a collar and ID tags at all times.
- Dogs must never be left unattended or out of sight
- Dogs that show aggression toward people or other animals must be removed immediately from the park. Dogs who exhibit a history of aggressive behavior will have their privileges revoked.
- Owners will be responsible for all damage or injury inflicted by their dog(s).
- Owners are required to clean up & dispose of all waste left by their dogs.
- Dogs in heat/season are not permitted.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months old.
- Children under the age of 16 shall not be permitted in the park without adult supervision. It is recommended that small children not be allowed in the park.
- Failure to comply with these posted Rules/Regulations and Village Ordinances will result in expulsion from the park. Continued failure to comply on subsequent visits may results in permanent revocation of privileges and or criminal prosecution.
- Registration is required annually (Registration begins in May of every year)
- **In the event of an emergency, persons are urged to call 911.**
- Hours of operation are 5:30a,-9:00pm Monday-Sunday Per Ordinance no. 2007-22
- If key for the dog park is lost, resident must fill out a new registration form and purchase a new permit.
